Subject: RSV2000

Some of you may be aware that Mr John Rautenbach and Mr Ryan Leach, after being disciplined by the Federation, have resigned from our organisation and formed a club under the auspices of the KUSA and linked this club to the RSV2000.

The RSV2000 is a small fanatical group of about 300 members that broke away from the SV a few years ago under the leadership of Dr Helmut Raiser after a number of court cases by the SV to get rid of him. Although affiliated to the Verband für Deutsche Hundewesen (VDH or German Kennel Club) and recognized by the FCI, the SV does not support or recognize the RSV2000.

Involvement with the RSV2000 is not in the Federation's interest and how to deal with this group will be on the agenda of the forthcoming Council meeting.

In the meanwhile, you are requested not to involve your club in any of the activities being promoted by this grouping and to urge your members to remain loyal to the SV and the Federation and avoid same.
