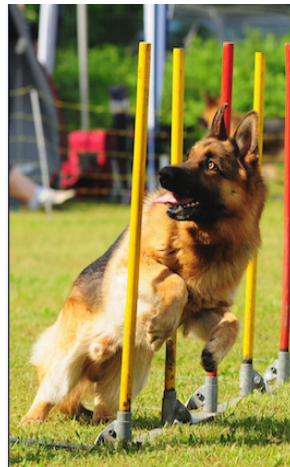

Where?

When?

Thursday 15.11.2012 and Friday 16.11.2012:

Training of teams (on carpet)
Training times will be assigned

Friday, 16.11.2012:

20:00 o'clock and welcome the invasion and subsequent nations draw

Saturday 17.11.2012 and Sunday 18.11.2012:

Each one A-run and two runs Jumping

How?

It begins at 9:00 with the A-clock operation. The last race on Sunday will take place in reverse order of the ranked teams so far.

There are two judges used, which are set diagonally. The Judge of the A-run on Saturday judges the jumping races on Sunday and the Judge of the A run from Sunday will judge the Jumping Runs on Saturday.

It is carried out individual and teamstandings.

The course requirements of the SV-Bundessiegerprüfung, each with 20 obstacles and 3.5 m/s assumed for the A-cycles and 4.0 m/s are used for jumping courses for the WUSV Agility World Championships.

One team per country can be reported with up to five teams and a replacement team.

Germany as the host can register in 2012 two teams that will result from the first 12 rankings of SV-Bundessiegerprüfung, i. e. Team 1 consists of the placement of the SV-Bundessiegerprüfung 1-5 is plus space 11 as a substitute, team 2 from the placements of the SV-Bundessiegerprüfung 60-10 than plus 12 spare space.

Conditions or pre-qualifications of the team:

Teams must qualify through an association or sighting in the championship level A2/A3.
