Directives for collection, storage and dispatch of blood samples

1. No litters will be accepted for registration if both sire and dam concerned have not been DNA profiled or proven through the Federation's DNA scheme.
2. Note that DNA testing is only **one** of the requirements for breeding. Owners must ensure that all requirements described in the Breed Ordinance are met before allowing a mating to take place.
3. Collect 1x 5ml tube unclotted blood from each dog. Samples must be collected in glass EDTA-solution tubes. Mix samples gently to ensure proper mixing of contents.
4. State clearly on each tube the name and tattoo number of the dog – this must co-incide with the details on this identification form. The dog's name and physical tattoo number in its ear must be checked by the Veterinarian before taking the blood sample.
5. As soon as possible after collection, place the blood in a refrigerator but **DO NOT FREEZE**. Pack the samples securely to prevent breakage, with a cold pack in polystyrene or other suitable cool-box.
6. Send samples together with the fully completed identification form by the most rapid means possible (e.g. courier). Avoid sending samples late in the week and prior to statutory holiday weekends. Keep samples chilled until dispatched.
7. Please use block lettering and ensure that all information on this form is correct and completely filled in, clearly stating whether the sample is for proving or profiling.
8. All samples must be sent to the following address:

9. The costs pertaining to the taking of the blood sample must be paid directly to the Veterinarian.
10. In addition, the laboratory and an administration fee is also payable by the member directly to the Federation. **No blood will be processed unless the full payment is received by the Federation.**
11. The official pedigree, together with the relevant laboratory and administration fee should be forwarded to the Federation by the owner immediately after the taking of the sample.



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
