Re: **Selection Criteria: WUSV IPO Championship Trial**

The National Sport Committee requested that all members aspiring for selection to the National team representing the Federation at the WUSV IPO Championship Trial take note of the following selection criteria:

- must be a GSD Federation of SA member in good standing
- must be a resident of South Africa for at least 6 (six) months prior to the GSDFSA IPO Nationals
- must have competed in a Club Trial at least 6 (six) months prior to the GSDFSA IPO Nationals
- must have scored a minimum of 260 points in total with 90 in C (Protection Work) at the Club Trial mentioned above
- must have competed at the GSDFSA IPO Nationals with a minimum of score of 250 points in total, with a minimum of 80 points in each phase, as per WUSV requirements.
- the top 5 (five) scoring candidates may be selected to represent the Federation in the WUSV Trial within the above criteria
- additionally, 2 (two) reserves may be selected for the WUSV team provided that the aforementioned criteria have been met.

The Club Trial named above may be presented as a normal local club trial.

The GSDFSA IPO National Championship Trial will be judged by a SV Judge allowing for international scoring in order to assess that dogs are suitable to represent South Africa and compete in the WUSV Trial.
