Decisions taken at WUSV Meeting re South Africa

23 September 2022

- 1. South Africa to be allowed to continue awarding V gradings according to their existing rules until 1 January 2025.
- 2. South Africa to be allowed to continue awarding VA(SA) gradings according to their own rules.
- 3. SV Judges to be sensitized re Points 1 & 2 upon requests for clearance.
- 4. The awards granted as per Points 1 & 2 will not be recognized by the WUSV or the SV
- 5. Identification and DNA to be administered in South Africa.
- 6. HD and ED to be according to South Africa's own scheme provided the evaluator is accredited by Prof Talheim, such evaluation to be made on the internet submission of 5 Digital X-rays.
- 7. Information re membership numbers (where available) and show entry numbers of WUSV Countries' Sieger Shows to be freely available and published on the WUSV website.
- 8. Current rules re the required working trials for a V grading: List of acceptable trials to be expanded to include the following in alternative to IGP1, HGH and/or ZAP:

Utility Trial, Agility, Obedience, BH, Rescue Dog, Tracking Dog
